Disney Grants 126K lbs. of Fresh Produce to Feeding America Riverside | San Bernardino

(Riverside, CA – July 29, 2022) – The Walt Disney Company granted Feeding America Riverside | San Bernardino (FARSB) funding to source and distribute 126,000 pounds of fresh, healthy produce to Inland Empire families in need.
