Our community is no stranger to devastation. Just last year, our region suffered the damaging effects caused by the Cranston and Holy Fires, and earlier this year, many of our own were living in uncertainty as we faced the longest government shut-down in history.

Recently, our local neighbors in

the Trona and Ridgecrest communities have been devastated by 2 earthquakes and over 3,000 aftershocks that have caused severe damage. As a result, many families have been forced to live in temporary shelters and/or tents.

Our food bank takes a proactive approach in providing aide and feeding those in need. In addition to our emergency food and water distributions, we use our network of community partners to provide assistance beyond what our emergency relief provides. From providing food, to meal cards and gas cards, Feeding America Riverside|San Bernardino (FARSB) has become so much more than a food bank. ## **Hunger Stories: Meet Iliana**

Iliana Medrano is seven years old and dreams of becoming a doctor.

"I want to be a doctor when I grow up because they help people just like summer meals are helping us," she said.



During the summer, Iliana and her 6-year-old

brother, Armanie, visit a summer meals program organized by a partner of the Feeding America network.

"The meals lift a burden for me," said their mother, Jessica. "They keep the kids fed during the summer."

During the school year, Jessica works for a temp agency, getting consistent work in warehouses around her home. When Iliana and Armanie are out of school during the summer, Jessica can't afford daycare, so she stays home, resulting in a tight budget and an often empty pantry.

"It's so hard when I don't have an income during the summer, but I don't have a choice," she said. "Sending both kids to daycare five days a week would be too expensive." That's why the summer meals program is so important to her family.

## Fighting Hunger in the Summer



We have served over 800 households through this program and expect to feed over 900 more before the end of the summer!
